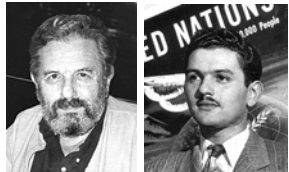


## Trustees -- NSA Anthology Charitable Trust
